If you become unwell while attending the event, please locate event staff, security or first aid personnel immediately. The first aid tent is located near the information tent. The Event team will implement relevant COVID safe practices as per the approved COVID Safe event plan.

Right to Refuse

Event staff and security have the right to refuse entry into the event space should an attendee display COVID-19 symptoms.
